Qualitative Methods in Social Sciences: Ethnography, Narratives and Social Stories

Duration: 5 days

Eligible participants: Students/ researchers/ teachers in research institutions/ universities/ colleges, professionals in government organisations and NGOs

Course contents: Understanding peculiarity of Indian society; different methods of qualitative research; selecting the field; relating with the field by blurring the boundaries of outsider and insider; selection of respondents; family tree and biographical notes of respondents; retrieving the memories; semi structured and un-structured interviews (*Baat-se-baat* methodology); focused group discussions (FGDs) to validate the facts and fill in the incomplete stories; capturing the silence, murmuring, half sentences; inclusion of left out resources (proverbs, folk stories and songs); content analysis and discourse analysis; visual representation of qualitative data; writing social stories.

Course fee: Rs. 3000/- (inclusive of kit bag, course material, lunch & refreshments)
